



Information about the launch of generic Afinitor

Effective Dec. 14, 2019, generic Afinitor (everolimus) is not covered by CarePlus plans; brand Afinitor will continue to be covered with prior authorization (PA) and can be filled for the patient.

Prescriber frequently asked questions on generic Afinitor

1. Q: Is generic Afinitor (everolimus) being covered at the pharmacy?

A: For CarePlus plans, brand-name Afinitor is covered with prior authorization (PA) and can be filled for your patients; generic Afinitor is not covered.

2. Q: Why isn't everolimus covered?

A: CarePlus decided not to cover everolimus at this time; brand-name Afinitor is on the formulary.

3. Q: Can I request an exception for everolimus?

A: Yes, but the cost share for everolimus may be the same as or higher than brand-name Afinitor.

4. Q: Will everolimus be covered in the future?

A: Yes, CarePlus may cover generic everolimus at some point in the future.

5. Q: Will everolimus ever be cheaper?

A: Yes, eventually everolimus may be cheaper than Afinitor; this will occur in the future.
